While Polycarbonate is still approved by the FDA, and regulatory agencies world wide, for use in sports bottles, we felt that the responsible course was to make the switch. All plastic drink ware in our line is manufactured from a selection FDA approved, BPA free resins.

In keeping with our commitment to conducting our business affairs in a socially responsible manner, we strive to provide our customers with products that meet or exceed their expectations.
