Leed's is committed to applying the highest standards of safety for its products. In order to meet both the needs of our customers and the regulatory requirements of the markets we serve, Leed's requires all products purchased to meet our design specifications. We take all necessary steps to ensure that our products meet Federal product regulations and require our suppliers to obtain required permits and / or approvals from appropriate US Federal agencies.

Regarding California's Proposition 65 rules, decorating and printing inks used on Leed's products that are decorated in the USA have been fully tested and do not contain chemicals at concentrations that would require a Proposition 65 warning label. Safe Harbor Level limits have not been fully established by Proposition 65 for all materials used in Leed's products. In order to comply with California's regulations, products intended for distribution within the state should be marked with a Prop 65 warning.
